

Used Washing Machine Buyer's Checklist

Inspect Before You Buy

1 Spin the drum by hand

Smooth turn, no grinding or loose play in the bearings.

2 Look for rust and leaks

Check the base, back, and detergent drawer for stains.

3 Smell inside and check the seal

Musty odour or a torn, mouldy gasket are warning signs.

4 Run a full test cycle

Watch it fill, drain fully, and spin without heavy shaking.

5 Listen on the high-speed spin

A loud roar usually means worn drum bearings.

Confirm the Deal

1 Check the model age

Four to six years old is a strong value sweet spot.

2 Get the warranty in writing

Length and coverage, store backed for a used machine.

3 Ask about delivery and removal

Quote both so the final cost is a fair comparison.

4 Plan the installation

Level footing, hot and cold water, and a proper drain.
